Year 8, 9 and 10 trip to CERN, Switzerland, March 2018

The Science department is proposing to take a residential school trip to Geneva, Switzerland from Wednesday 14th March to Friday 16th March 2018. The trip is open to students who will be in Year 8, 9 and 10 from September 2017.

The cost of the trip will be around £350 for 3 days and will primarily involve a visit to the famous scientific establishment, CERN (European Organisation for Nuclear Research). We will be travelling by coach to Birmingham airport and then flying to Geneva, Switzerland. The accommodation will be in a centrally located youth hostel. There will also be trips to the Science Museum and the Natural History Museum in Geneva.

We have limited numbers and anticipate this to be a popular trip. Students who did not get a place last time will be offered first refusal on this trip. After that, if it is oversubscribed, we will draw names out of a hat. As with all school trips, students' behaviour and work will be expected to remain of a good standard during the year in order to take part in this trip.
